During the Gulf War (1990-1991), more than 4,000 members of the Canadian Armed Forces served in the Persian Gulf. Canadian warships and warplanes were sent to aid an international coalition mandated by the United Nations which sought to drive invading Iraqi forces out of Kuwait. The Canadian military operation was codenamed Operation FRICTION and lasted nearly a year. However, Canada remained in the



Drocourt-Quéant Line

The Drocourt-Quéant Line, a section of the infamous Hindenburg Line, was one of the most strongly defended German defence systems in the First World War. The Germans had spent over two years securing the position and had reinforced it with concrete bunkers and machine gun nests. To capture the enemy trenches the Canadians would have to advance through five belts of barbed wire and overcome seven battle-hardened German

area to enforce peacekeeping efforts for several years after the war. This was known as Operation BARRIER.
