August 8, 1918 is simultaneously referred to as “the Black Day of the German Army” and the first of Canada’s Hundred Days. The Germans were not expecting the Canadians to attack. Following the Canadian victory at Vimy Ridge, the German army had been keeping a close eye on Canadian troop movements.
