First off, I'd like to draw everyone's attention to a book review by Colonel (Ret'd) Brett Boudreau, published in *FrontLine Defence*, of Major-General (Ret'd) David Fraser's new book on **Operation MEDUSA**. Fought in September 2006, it is arguably one of the most important operations from Afghanistan, not only for Canada, but for NATO as well. To date, MEDUSA is certainly the most studied and written about battle from Canada's mission in South West Asia. Fraser's book can now be set beside, amongst others, Colonel (Ret'd) Bernd Horn's *No Lack of Courage* (Dundurn, 2010), Adam Day's *Witness to War* (Magic Light, 2010) and my own *In Their Own Words: Canadian Stories of Valour and Bravery from Afghanistan, 2001-2007* (CDA Press, 2013) that offers first-person accounts of the battle by those who fought it. Be sure to check it out!

Recently, Major-General (Ret'd) Denis Thompson, a CDA Institute Research Fellow, offered his comments to the Standing Committee on National Defence concerning peacekeeping. Given Canada's impending mission in Mali, his remarks are timely indeed. An audio recording of his
