The re-designation of Force Troops Command (FTC) to 6th (United Kingdom) Division (6 (UK) Div) will provide the Army's asymmetric edge, orchestrating Intelligence, Counter-Intelligence, Information Operations, Electronic Warfare, Cyber and unconventional warfare. 6 (UK) Div will include: 1st Signal Brigade, 11th Signal Brigade, 1st Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance Brigade, 77th Brigade and the Specialist Infantry Group.

Two lessons from the article:

- 1. Number of ships in a fleet is important when a government is facing multiple national objectives.
- 2. Having a robust ships engineering system, with yards, maintenance units and trained staff, is important to keep a fleet readiness level up. A rule-of-thumb is one third of a fleet deployable/deployed, one third preparing for or returning from deployment, and one third is long-term unavailability for maintenance.

"The oldest Type 23s will be 30/35 years old when the Type 26s come in..." "That is ancient in warship terms. Old ships cost more to keep running and they break down more often." Fleets should be re-capitalized so ships do not age out. 30 years is a good target to 'life-cycle' a warship.

On 2 August 2019 the Government of Canada announced that the Canadian Coast Guard (CCG) will be procuring six new program icebreakers to replace its current aging fleet of icebreakers.

Some information received in response to queries resulting from the announcement:

- 1. The six new icebreakers are new and separate from the Government announcement in May 2019 of 18 vessels for the CCG, two of which will be based on the Navy's Arctic and Offshore Patrol Ship design.
- 2. The 16 new Multi-Purpose Vessels (MPV) announced in May will all be light icebreakers. The six new 'Program Icebreakers' announced 2 August will replace medium and heavy icebreakers in the Coast Guard fleet.

The Aussies have got to figure out how to do forward defence as well as all round defence.
