





There are numerous Canadian reports but I'm not aware of any single product which equals the comprehensive scope of this Congressional Research Service (CRS) review. Also, note that this report

is version #146, an "update" to a stream of previous releases to a report originating in 2010 (not all of which have been "published"). The trend of increasing content % change of these updates (see: https://www.everycrsreport.com/reports/R41153.html) may suggest CRS is responding to increased interest and priority of Arctic issues within the US Congress (and other US government departments and agencies) or perhaps that "Changes in the Arctic" are truly accelerating.
