How China Built an Army of Influence Agents in the U.S.



The Daily Beast article "How China Built an Army of Influence Agents in the U.S." brings up the use of the United Front, which the article states is a long time Communist Chinese organization used throughout the world to actively promote Communist Chinese Party (CCP) policies and to oppose actions by other governments that are opposite to the wishes of the CCP. This would include Fulun Gong, Tibetan independence, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and opposition to the illegal Chinese creation and occupation of artificial islands in the South China Sea.

China is "attacking" the West non-kinetically (operations other than war) by way of influence activities, creating or usurping Chinese associations and often sidelining long term Chinese associations using money channeled through the Chinese Embassy or a Chinese philanthropist as we have seen in Australia. China has also attempted to use financial warfare and lawfare as part of the "Three Wars Concept" adopted by the CCP in 2003.

Although Canada is not mentioned, it is conceivable that we are being influenced in the same way. Certainly, Chinese influence is growing which in itself is not bad ... until one adds the wishes and expectations of the CCP.

China cannot be ignored. Their trade is welcome within limits - their active influence on our politics, policies and society as part of the CCP United Front operations are not, especially when they support the CCP's illegal actions and occupation of foreign countries. As Sir Winston Churchill once said "It is better to jaw jaw than war war." And we should do our best to understand that China is not benign, it is doing some very corrupt and illegal activities in order to influence us. We should be wary and expect this. In other words, keep our eyes open and expect these actions and act accordingly.

This concern about Chinese telecoms has been under scrutiny for some time in Australia, the US and the UK with all these countries taking action of some sort in regard to communication security and Chinese influence overall. Canada does not share that concern as yet, although the latest AECON construction company decision shows that concern is quietly growing here as well. Interestingly, at least two Canadian telecoms/wireless providers are using Huawei or ZTE products even though those particular products have given rise of concern by our allies. It is something to think about when looking at future business proposals.

The Yuri Dolgoruky is returning to its manufacturer for repairs. It is the lead ship of the Borei class of ballistic missile submarines consisting of three submarines. The Borei A class is the next version based on some of the initial shortcomings of the Borei class. Originally there was to be a third version called the Borei B, but this was shelved in favour of increasing the number of Borei As to be built from five to


nine hulls. This will eventually give Russia 12 hulls.

All these classes use the Bulava missile which has not thus far resolved all its shortcomings, however this is true of any new complex system. Most recently, a salvo of four missiles was fired successfully from this same submarine, so at least some of the issues appear to be resolved.

The repair facility four fourth generation submarine does not appear to be operational as yet at Severodvinsk. The report states that the submarine will undergo "medium repairs" and there is no set schedule for their completion.

It will be interesting to see how long it will actually take to deliver this repaired submarine. Will it also require the long in the tooth Delta IV class to soldier on for even longer? What does it say about the Russian nuclear capability?





"The Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) require enhanced capabilities to engage and defeat non-cooperative objects using non-kinetic means. The evolution of laser technologies makes them increasingly applicable to dazzle, jam or damage optical sensors, including imaging systems, thermal sights, and seekers. In addition, they can also be used for the detection of hostile systems.

Current laser technologies suffer however from a combination of insufficient efficiencies, low peak and average powers, and excessive SWaP (size, weight and power). These drawbacks limit their employment for the aforementioned applications, their engagement ranges, and the possibilities of integrating them onto mobile platforms where space and power supply are severely constrained.

Russia will take measures in response to drawing Sweden and Finland into NATO – Shoigu 7/24/2018 16:23:34

Moscow. 24 July. Interfax-AVN-RF will take measures in response to active cooperation between Sweden and Finland with NATO, Russian Defence Minister Sergei Shoigu said.

"The involvement of NATO in Finland and Sweden is worrying, and in May a treaty was signed that provides for their full participation in the exercises of the alliance and the possibility of using its command and control systems for troops and weapons." In exchange, NATO received unhindered access to the airspace and territorial waters of these countries, "said Minister at the collegium of the department on Tuesday.

"Such steps by Western colleagues lead to the destruction of the existing security system in the world, generate even greater mistrust, forcing us to take retaliatory measures," S. Shoigu stressed.

He said that the NATO contingents in Eastern Europe are continuing to grow: since 2014 their number has increased from 2 to 15 thousand servicemen.

In his opinion, the intensity of the preparations for the alliance is constantly increasing.

"Over 100 exercises have been conducted since the beginning of the year, in which up to 80,000 servicemen participated, while the number of personnel annually attracted to the series of exercises increased 10-fold over five years, and the number of combat aviation increased from 11 units to 101," said the Minister.

He noted that "with the help of the United States in Europe deployed five centres of cyber operations - in Finland, Estonia, Poland, Germany and France."
